- Retrieve forgotten notes and ideas. Discover new relationships and connections in old notes and files.
- Examine retrieved paragraphs, expand to see context, insert in an open file, or open source file.
- Use Orbis to search note-taking files that are linked to your Ibidem database.
- Include Ibidem citations in your notes. When retrieved text is inserted in a file, any citations will be automatically reformatted to match.

**Lingua:** Extended multilingual support for Hebrew, Greek, Cyrillic, IPA and more.

- Type in Hebrew right to left with proper word wrap.
- Choose mnemonic or national keyboards.
- Add virtually any diacritics with NB's intuitive F6 compose key — fast keyboard control, easy to learn.
